This year, God willing, we will continue making the opportunity available to all our young girls between the ages of 5 to High School. As a reminder, each girl who participates should wear a *simple white dress*, something appropriate for Church and reflecting the solemnity of the occasion (we have several dresses that have been donated from past myrrh-bearers, which you are welcome to borrow on a first-come, first-serve basis).
